

TEF MINI-GRANT

The Tewksbury Education Foundation Teacher Mini-Grant Program was established to provide teachers with a resource to enhance the education of their students. The Mini-Grant Program is based on the belief that many successful programs begin in the classroom.

Guidelines:

- Grants will be awarded based on Educational Value, Innovation, Creativity, and benefit to students.
- Projects will be funded for a maximum of two consecutive years.
- They must first be approved by the Principal, then the Mini-Grant board, and the TEF Board of Directors.
- Every Grant will be reviewed by the Mini-Grant Board using a rubric. (The grant will need to obtain a score of 75 to be passed).

GRANT PROPOSALS DEMONSTRATE:

- Creativity in meeting a specific curriculum challenge in the classroom
- Direct benefit to students and/or school which can be measured
- Provide unique and/or higher concept learning
- Capture students' interest
- Neatly constructed and clearly defined
